

Mātauranga (Culture and Arts) Grants Eligibility Criteria

1

Grants shall be provided throughout the year provided that applications are made 12 weeks prior to the event or project deadline.

2

You may only make one application per financial year

The financial year is 1st October to 30th September.

3

Priority will be given to events, initiatives and activities which are being held within the Hauraki rohe and or have a Hauraki focus-kaupapa.

4

Applicants must also represent Hauraki at regional, national or international forums.

5

You must whakapapa to one or more of the Hauraki iwi and be registered with the Hauraki Māori Trust Board.

6

Where an application is made on behalf of a group/trust/ organisation, at least a significant majority of the persons benefiting from the grant must be registered with the Hauraki Māori Trust Board for the total grant to be applied. Where less than one half of its members whakapapa to one or more of the Hauraki iwi, then only a portion of the total grant will be available.

7

The Hauraki Māori Trust Board reserves the right to use your names, photo and other details in its publications, communications and social media.

8

The grant does not cover the purchase of fixed assets or capital items, wages, salaries or business ventures.

A photo of the applicant(s) must be provided with the application.
